Anderson Bridge: 23 April to 31 May 2025 VivoCity: 4 June to 4 July 2025

SINGAPOREAN PHOTOGRAPHER MELISA TEO LAUNCHES TWO RIVERS EXHIBITION & BOOK ON HISTORIC ANDERSON BRIDGE

Singapore, 17 March 2025 – Melisa Teo's highly anticipated photography exhibition, Two Rivers, inspired by her eponymous book, will debut on the historic Anderson Bridge, from April 23 to May 31, 2025. The exhibition then moves to VivoCity's Waterfront Promenade and Southwest Boulevard from June 4 to July 4, 2025.

Two Rivers is a captivating exploration of life, memory and dreams, featuring images from the Singapore River and the Seine River in Paris, France, and is the first exhibition to be held on Anderson Bridge. A joint initiative supported by the French and Singapore governments to commemorate 60 years of diplomatic relations, the exhibition is presented by the French Embassy as part of the *vOilah!* France-Singapore Festival, and supported by Singapore's Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth, National Arts Council, National Parks Board and Land Transport Authority, who provided the unique setting of Anderson Bridge. This National Monument, located at the mouth of the Singapore River, is a powerful symbol of the connection between nations, perfectly complementing Melisa's exploration of human interconnectedness.

The historical significance of this exhibition also underscores the longstanding relationship between Singapore and France, as we work towards a Comprehensive Strategic Partnership to further strengthen our ties.

Following its presentation on Anderson Bridge, the *Two Rivers* exhibition will move to VivoCity, Singapore's largest shopping mall. Mapletree Investments is the project's Diamond Partner, who has generously supported expanding the access to Melisa's evocative work. During this time, she will host an artist talk at library@harbourfront, sharing her creative journey. A children's art competition, inspired by the exhibition's theme, will further engage the community.

Melisa's distinctive vision, shaped by her dual heritage and life experiences, is evident throughout *Two Rivers*. Her photographs capture life's fluidity, mirroring the rivers' dynamic flow, and offering a compelling reflection on the past, the future, and the intricate web of human connections.



In her own words:

"I am a Singaporean living in Paris.
Two rivers mark the course of my life:
the Singapore River where I was born,
and the Seine River, where I was reborn.
The Singapore River carries my memories
and the Seine River, my dreams.
I left one behind, in search of the "self",
but discovered instead that all
our destinies are intertwined.
We are all connected to one another.
Just as all rivers eventually meet again at the sea,
we too are one."

ABOUT THE PHOTOGRAPHER

Melisa Teo is a Singaporean photographer who regards her camera as a "third eye" which is guided by intuition to perceive a reality that eludes the naked eye. For her, the camera is a transmitter and translator of light's messages and photography, a doorway bordering visible and invisible worlds.

Since 2008, she has been travelling through spiritual worlds in pursuit of the sacred. Her journeys have been documented in a number of books (*Light From Within*, *The Light Beyond*) and exhibitions (*Dark Light*, *Eden*).



In recent years, her fascination with the relationship between man and nature has led her from shamans in the forests of Siberia to anonymous figures in the manicured gardens of Paris, her adoptive city. Her latest book *The Trees of Paris* was published in 2020.

Melisa majored in English Language and Literature at the National University of Singapore and French Language and Literature at Sorbonne University in Paris.
